Dear Parents,

The New Lenox School Board of Education approved the new boundaries for the 2006-2007 school year at the Wednesday, April 26, 2006 school board meeting. Thank you for your patience through this process. Please note the following:

- The new boundary maps can be accessed at our district website, www.nlsd122.org
- Large boundary maps may be viewed Monday through Friday at the District Office, 102 S. Cedar Road or at each individual school.
- Current students will bring home a registration packet on or about May 4, 2006 which will include the name of the student's home school for the 2006-2007 school year based on the new boundaries. PLEASE WATCH FOR THIS VERY IMPORTANT PACKET.
- Current 7th Grade students who will be 8th graders in 2006-2007 WILL have the option of staying put at their current school. The preference information received by the District in March will determine the junior high school for the 2006-2007 school year.
- The Kindergarten Centers (Cherry Hill and Spencer Trail) have the following AM/PM boundaries for the 2006-2007 school year:

The boundary line is the WALKING TRAIL which extends from the far eastern boundary of our district towards the west, makes a move around Windermere East so as not to cut into a subdivision and extends along Washington Street as the far west boundary.

Cherry Hill AM-North of the Trail (includes Tiny Treasures Daycare)
 PM- South of the Trail

Spencer Trail AM-South of the Trail and
 Building Blocks Daycare, Mary Sears Daycare, Aunt
 Nancy's Daycare, Living Waters Daycare, Park District
 Daycare
 PM- North of the Trail
