Reading - This week, we will move from fiction to nonfiction texts as we read "The Moon Seems to Change". Our reading skills include main idea/details and obtaining information from illustrations.

Phonics - This week is a skills review over digraphs, plurals, VCCV, base and words and endings. The test over these review words will be Wednesday, October 27.

Grammar - Our grammar skills are working with nouns as subjects and subject/verb agreement in the past-tense.

Writing - We will begin to practice nonfiction writing this week as we focus on conveying ideas and information, learning about the various genres, and using illustrations to add information.

Math - We will find missing numbers and rules using tables. We will also begin estimating costs using mental math.

Science - We will begin Lesson 3: How Environments can Change. We will examine fast changing environments as well as how engineers can change environments.

This week in science we will be learning about how environments change.
