

Desert Biomes

Deserts can be very hot during the day and much cooler at night. There are deserts that are cold all the time.

Deserts are often defined as areas that receive less than 25 centimeters of rain or snow each year.

Desert Organisms

- **Desert plants—large root systems close to the surface of the ground.**
 - **These roots quickly take in any water from rain.**
