| hardy | <ul style="list-style-type: none">-able to survive under bad conditions; tough |
| mediocre | <ul style="list-style-type: none">-of low to medium quality; barely passable |
| monotonous | <ul style="list-style-type: none">-always the same; not varying; boring |

| monotony | -lack of variety resulting in boredom |
| originate | -to bring or come into being |
| origin | -a beginning or coming into being |
| punctuate | -to add marks such as commas and periods to writing to make the meaning clear -to interrupt from time to time |
| punctuation | -the use of marks such as commas and periods in writing |
| ravenous | -very hungry -eager for whatever satisfies one's needs or wants |
| realistic | -closely resembling real life -aware of things as they are; practical |
| soothe | -to make calm and relaxed -to relieve soreness; to make less painful |
| stampede | -a sudden rush of animals or people, usually caused by fear -to take part in a stampede |
