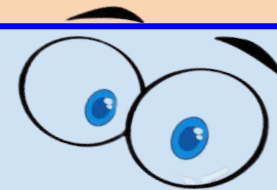

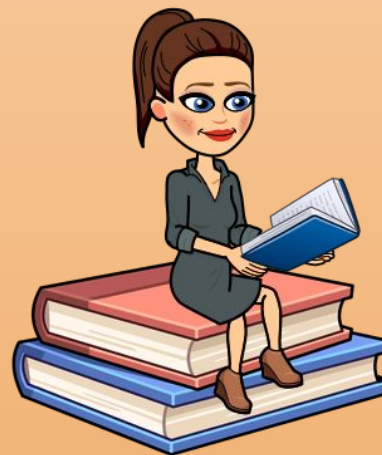

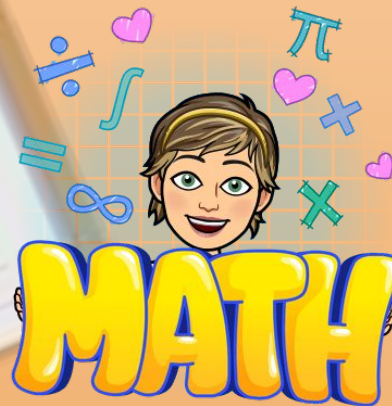
Social Studies-

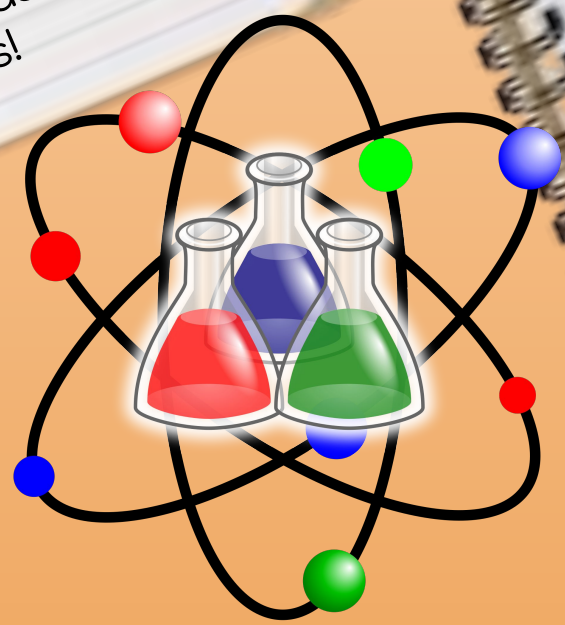
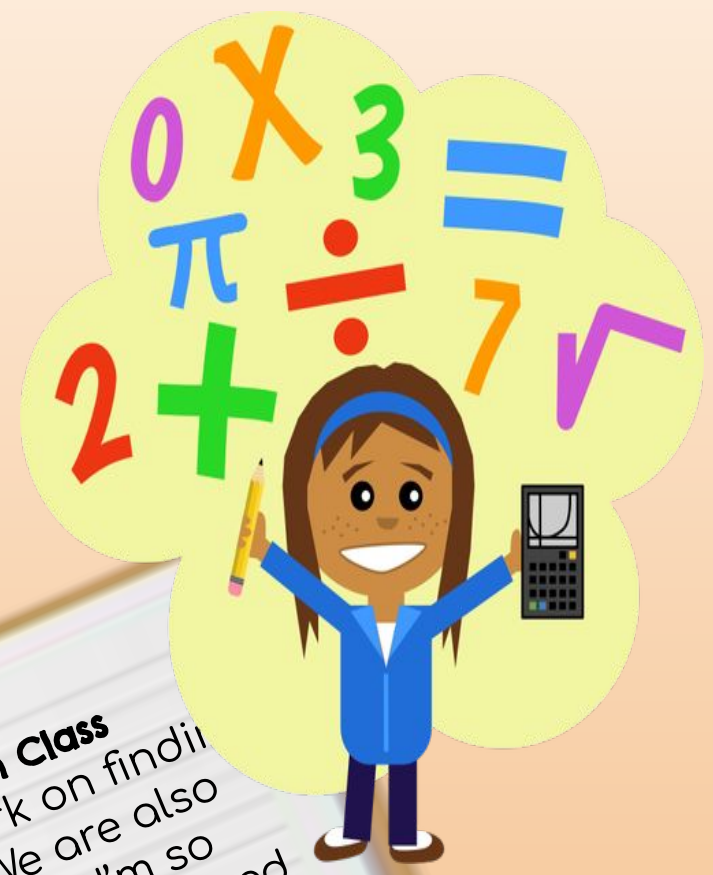
Mrs. Berwanger's Science/Social Studies Class

Reading Comprehension Strategies:

Questioning: When readers question the text before, during, and after they read. Some of the most interesting questions aren't always answered in the story.

Visualizing: When a reader can make a mental image in their head using the senses to help them imagine what they might smell, hear, see, taste, or feel as they read. This will help them g

Mrs. Deckinga's Instructional ELA Class

We are continuing to read our novel St. Louis Armstrong Beach in iLit and using comprehension strategies as we read. This week we focused on asking questions and visualizing the characters and setting in the novel. We are ending the week with planning an informative essay. Students used questions and a graphic organizer to brainstorm and organize their thoughts. Students also made ELA goals for the school year.
