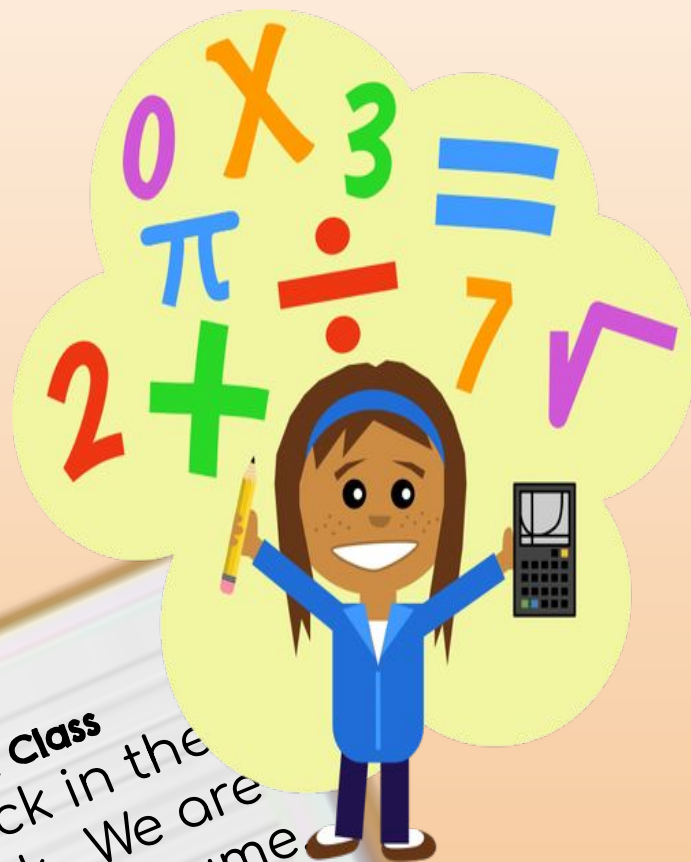
Mrs. Berwanger's Science/Social Studies Class

Instructional ELA

Reading Comprehension Strategies:

Questioning: When readers question the text before, during, and after they read. Some of the most interesting questions aren't always answered in the story.

Visualizing: When a reader can make a mental image in their head using the senses to help them imagine what they might smell, hear, see, taste, or feel as they read. This will help them get deeper into the text.

Mrs. Deckinga's Instructional ELA Class

We are continuing to read our novel St. Louis Armstrong Beach in iLit and using comprehension strategies as we read. This week we continued to focus on asking questions and visualizing the characters and setting in the novel. We also began a grammar unit on nouns and ended our week with taking the Fall Aimsweb benchmark assessments.
