<p style="text-align: center;">Mr. Balderman: Science/SS</p> <p>Science: We will be moving into science next week. Our first lesson will be on living things and ecosystems.</p> <p>Please check assignment notebooks and powerschool for any missing assignments and grades.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Mrs. Brost: ELA -</p> <p><u>Reading:</u> Novel, <u>Night of the Spadefoot Toads</u>. Lessons 8-9, Chapters 13-16.</p> <p><u>Skill:</u> Theme</p> <p><u>Foundational Skill:</u> Greek and Latin Roots.</p> <p><u>Grammar:</u> Indefinite Pronouns/ Pronoun-Antecedent Agreement. Grammar notes are in the virtual binder in Google Classroom.</p> <p><u>Spelling:</u> List 5. Contractions. Test on Friday. Assignments are posted daily in the ELA google classroom under "Assignment Book." Happy Fall Y'all!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Ms. Goad: Math</p> <p>Next week we will continue with Unit 2.</p> <p>Topics include: Volume, Area, Writing Expressions, Multiplication and Division.</p> <p>Students have several graded assessments in their portfolio to use as review guides. Please make sure to review these items with them.</p> <p>If a student receives a late for not having their homework completed, I will send home a late slip that will need to be signed and returned.</p> <p>Have a great weekend!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ms. Midlock: Science/SS/Math</p> <p>SOCIAL STUDIES: We finished our Native American unit this week. We discussed the 7 Native American cultural regions and learned about tribes and artifacts in each region. Check PowerSchool for updated social studies grades. Next week, we will be switching to science.</p> <p>MATH: This week we finished up unit 1 and took our final unit test. These will be sent home on Monday. Please review your child's test to see their progress on Unit 1 standards. Next week we will begin unit 2, which is place value, multiplication, and division.</p> <p><i>We complete a notebook page for every new concept we learn in Math. If students are struggling at home, remind them to bring home their Math notebooks to review what we went over during class.</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Mrs. Sieger: ELA</p> <p>In reading, we will continue Night of the Spadefoot Toads. Our reading skill will be theme. We will be on List 5 in spelling next week. Our word pattern will be contractions. We will be testing on Thursday, September 23 instead of Friday, due to our half day! In grammar, we will look at pronouns and in foundational skills we continue our study of Greek and Latin roots. I hope everyone has a great weekend!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Mrs. Worden: ELA</p> <p>In reading, we will continue Night of the Spadefoot Toads. We read about Ben and Mrs. Tibbets finding the spadefoot toads on a very rainy night and we wrote our own stories about the mythical creature, "The Overtoad." Students were very creative! We will be on List 5 in spelling next week. Our word pattern will be contractions. We will be testing on Thursday, September 23 instead of Friday, due to our half day! We will continue to look at Greek and Latin roots in Foundational Skills, and pronouns in Grammar. Block 1.2 will be doing their writing test on Monday, but everyone else is finished with Aims. Everyone worked really hard!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Mrs. Berwanger: Science/Social Studies</p> <p>This week we will be starting Lesson 4 in Science. We will be researching the question, "What is the role of decomposers in an ecosystem?" Due to Friday being a half day, the test may have to be the following week.</p> <p>Please check assignment notebooks for updates. If you haven't seen previous tests, please check your child's folder. We will not start Social Studies until we finish Unit 1 for Science.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Mr. Mitrovic: ELA/Math</p> <p>ELA: We are continuing this week working through our book "Alamo Wars." This week, we are diving deeper into choosing the correct endings for plural nouns, as well as making predictions. Aims has been completed and focus has been top notch!</p> <p>MATH: We completed quiz corrections on our fractions assessment, and are working this week on fraction/decimal relationships, as well as word problems, individual IEP goals, and automaticity of multiplication problems. Looking forward to a great week!</p>
