CDC recommends that everyone 6 months of age and older receive a Flu Shot.

- Quadrivalent Flu vaccine will be provided for adults and children.
- High-Dose Flu vaccine is available for persons 65 years and older.
- Egg-free Flu vaccine is available for persons 2 years old and older who are allergic to eggs.

Flu Shots are administered according to CDC Guidelines, based on vaccine availability.

(Medicare/Medicaid accepted- Please bring your Medicare/Medicaid Card)

Low-cost Flu Shots for those who are uninsured or under-insured

No one will be denied immunization due to true inability to pay




Lines from the LRC

October was a busy month in the LRC! The fourth and fifth graders continued to use Destiny Discover to search for new books. Notes from the Easel

Art is being made here at Oakview, and I'm excited to be sharing my materials with the students so they can paint and use bigger paper again. Each grade level has a progressive curriculum designed to improve your child's artistic ability, and flourish their creativity. Here's a look at some of the art projects we will be starting this year.

4th grade is finishing with their Name Monsters. They have created these by writing their names facing together in a mirror image form. Then they had to use those lines to create a unique monster, Alien, or creature design. This project usually brings out the most creative designs.

5th grade finished painting monochromatic moonscapes. Students start with white as a tint, and then add scoops of one color only to create a radiating design which shows a slow decrease of light coming from the moon. They then hand paint their own spooky trees in black.

6th grade is creating one point perspective covered bridges. They learn how to create depth in a landscape by drawing objects larger and closer to the viewer and smaller and farther away from the viewer. I love doing these in the fall so the students can use lots of colors in the trees and surrounding environment.

I will try my hardest to monitor and evaluate each student as best as I can during this time, and mostly, give them a chance to make and share their art with others. Look for my monthly newsletter for any special announcements, or even just to hear about some of the upcoming projects they will be working on. Thank you for your patience, and support for the arts, and I hope we have a great year.









PTC Wizard Online Conference Scheduling System PARENT INSTRUCTIONS

HOW TO SCHEDULE A CONFERENCE

- Go to the NLSD website, and select Schedule Parent-Teacher Conferences under the Parents/Students main menu. Click on your school. <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If you have multiple students in multiple schools, you will need to return to this page and follow the below steps for each school!
- Click the red button Create Account! and enter your first name, last name, email and password in the resulting window, then click Register.
 <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: All parents will need to register as a first-time user, even if they used the scheduling system last year.



3. Fill in your child's first and last name and click the **Save** button.



4. You will need to consent to emails in order to receive your conference schedule via the email. Enter your email address, check the **I consent** box, and click **Submit**.



5. Add the Add a Meeting screen you can add additional children who attend the same school by clicking on **Account Settings** in the top-right, next to Sign Out. You could then click **+ADD** to add a child on the Account Settings screen.

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6. Click the big Add a Meeting button and select a conference type (<u>Either</u> <u>ZOOM or In Person</u>) then day; A list of teachers will appear. Select a teacher and then click on available time slot. If no available times work for you on the first day of conferences, you can select a different day in the date selection box.



7. You will get a pop-up message informing you that a meeting has been scheduled.



8. After closing the confirmation pop-up, you will be taken to your conference schedule screen. You can print your schedule of conferences from this screen with the Print icon (your schedule will also be emailed to you). To schedule other conferences with other teachers or for other students at the same school, select the **+ Add a Meeting** button to follow the steps again.
