

Science - We continued to study structures in animals for the senses.


Social Studies - We are starting to read about the Southeast Region of the U.S.

Afternoon Students (English Language Arts)


We are reading the story "Why the Sea is Salty", and looking at words with the prefixes DIS, RE, and NON.
