<p>Ms. Goad: Math</p> <p>After break we will be starting Unit 4.</p> <p>Unit 4 topics include: Decimals & +/- Fractions & Mixed Numbers</p> <p>All students have notes in their spiral and notes on +/- fractions are in our math Google classroom.</p> <p>Please make sure that you are looking in your child's portfolio to review their graded assessments with them. Ask your students about their maps and adventures we went on today! When we come back from break, we will be switching to Unit 2 of Science to learn about Earth's Systems.</p> <p><i>MATH:</i> We will be continuing Unit 3 when we return from break, which involves adding and subtracting fractions, mixed numbers, and improper fractions. Continue practicing multiplication, division, and fractions on IXL!</p>
