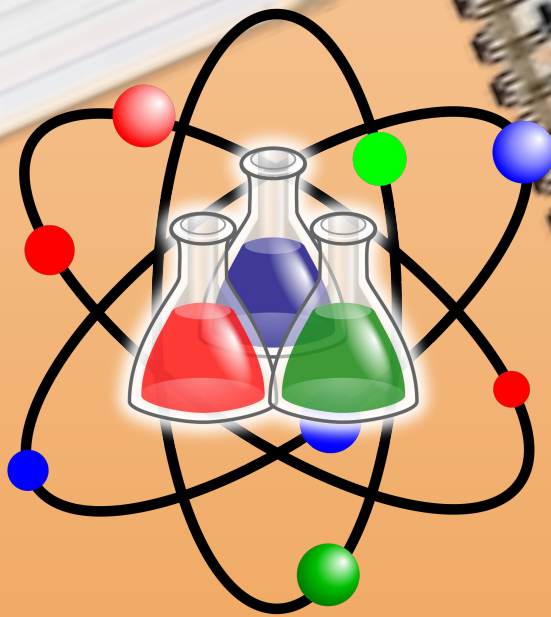
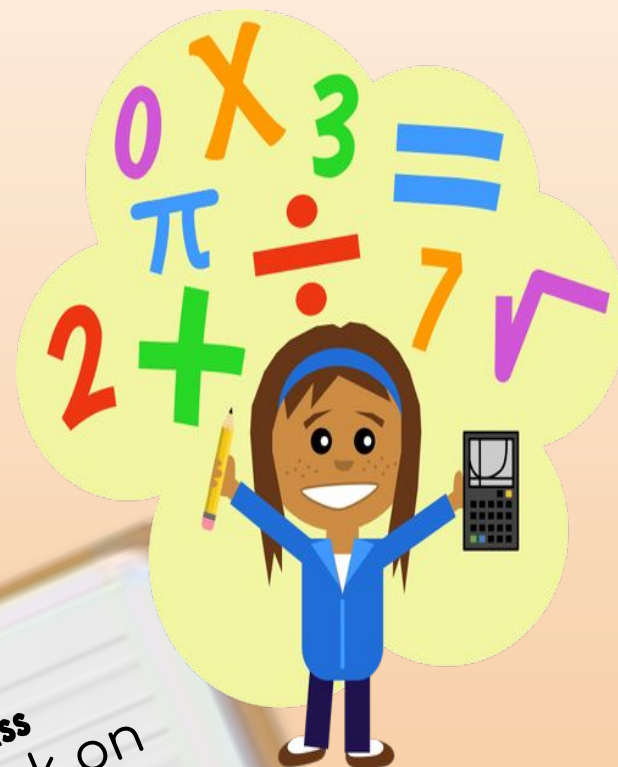
**Mrs. Berwanger's Science/Social
