<p>Mr. Balderman: Science/SS Science: We began Unit 3 this week and will continue with it next week. Next week we will use our observation skills and what we learned about substances with different properties to identify a mystery substance.</p> <p>Please check powerschool for missing work and grades.</p>	<p>Mrs. Brost: ELA <u>Reading:</u> Unit 2A: Operation Clean Sweep. Available on the NLSD app: Realize. <u>Skill:</u> Theme, Opinion Writing <u>Foundational Skill:</u> -s, -ed, -ing <u>Grammar:</u> Independent Clauses Grammar notes are in the virtual binder in Google Classroom. <u>Spelling:</u> No Test this week. Assignments are posted daily in the ELA google classroom under "Assignment Book."</p>
<p>Ms. Goad: Math</p> <p>Next week we will be continuing with Unit 6. We are working on creating Line Plots and finding the Data Landmarks. We will also be multiplying decimals.</p> <p>Students were given notes on the Data Landmarks and they should be memorizing them.</p> <p>Please check your child's assignment notebook each night to see if they have homework.</p> <p>Students should be using IXL and Reflex to reinforce skills.</p> <p>All students have the opportunity to come and see me during WIN time every day to get extra help.</p>	<p>Ms. Midlock: Science/SS/Math</p> <p>SCIENCE: We are continuing Unit 3 on the study of matter. We examined solutions and mixtures, along with looking at different properties of matter. We will continue Unit 3 next week, and we will start looking at how matter can change.</p> <p>MATH: This week we wrapped up Unit 5. We learned how to divide fractions by whole numbers, and we began reviewing all Unit 5 skills. Students received a study guide on Thursday. The study guide will be due on Tuesday, and the Unit 5 test will be Tuesday. (<i>I previously said Wednesday but due to IAR testing, it will now be on Tuesday March 8</i>). Students should be reviewing their notes, study guides, and iXL to prepare for the test.</p>
<p>Mrs. Sieger: ELA Next week, we begin testing for IAR. We will not do ReadyGEN or Spelling. We will focus on reinforcing learned skills, diagramming, and our Passion Projects.</p> <p>**Please check that your child has working headphones. We use them almost every day. Thank you!</p>	<p>Mrs. Worden: ELA I think students enjoyed learning in centers during this week for Choose Your Own Ed-Venture. They worked really hard and it was wonderful to read in small groups again! Hooray! We will not have a spelling list next week, due to testing. That means no homework either! We will continue centers and small reading groups. In ReadyGen, we will read and discuss the story "Operation Clean Sweep." We will continue work on sentence diagramming. We will continue to work on Opinion Writing.</p>
<p>Mrs. Berwanger We will continue to work on Unit 2 in Science. We are currently finishing up Lesson 6. The students are using questions to find answers in the text that they will highlight on their own. We will not test on this lesson. However, they will use questions from the test to practice highlighting information in the text that is important.</p>	<p>Mr. Mitrovic ELA - Students have been working hard on their Biography projects and will be presenting this week. We will begin our new spelling list, as well as studying words with silent consonants. MATH - Students have been doing a great job adding/subtracting/multiplying fractions with different denominators, as well as working with improper fractions and mixed numbers. We will test on this material early in the week.</p>
