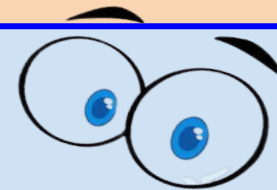

Please talk to your son or daughter about supplies they may be lacking in class! Pencils - pens - red pens - spiral notebooks.



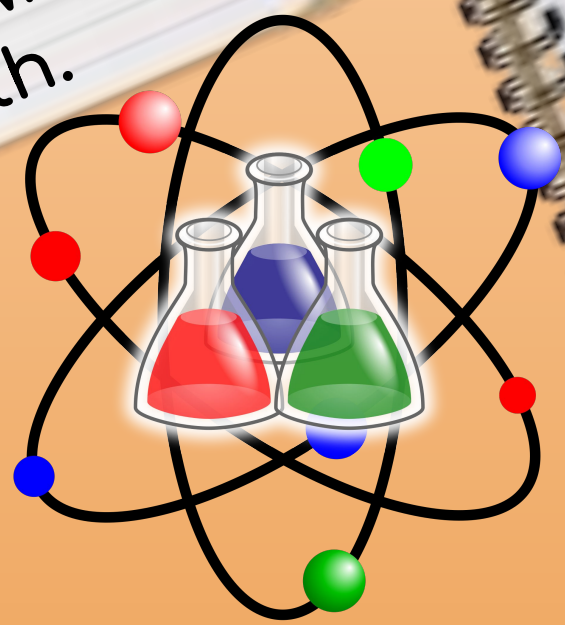

Studies Class

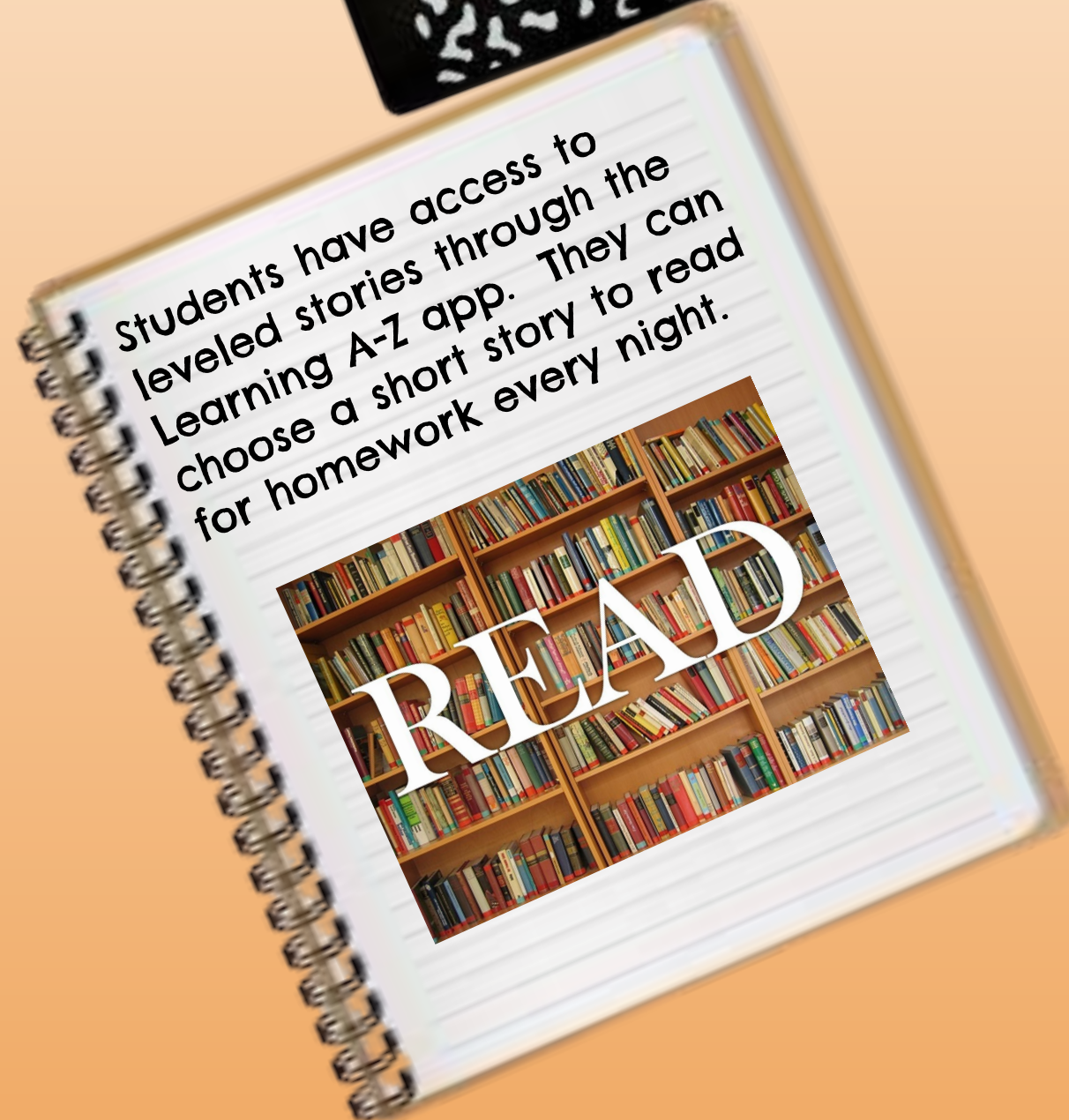
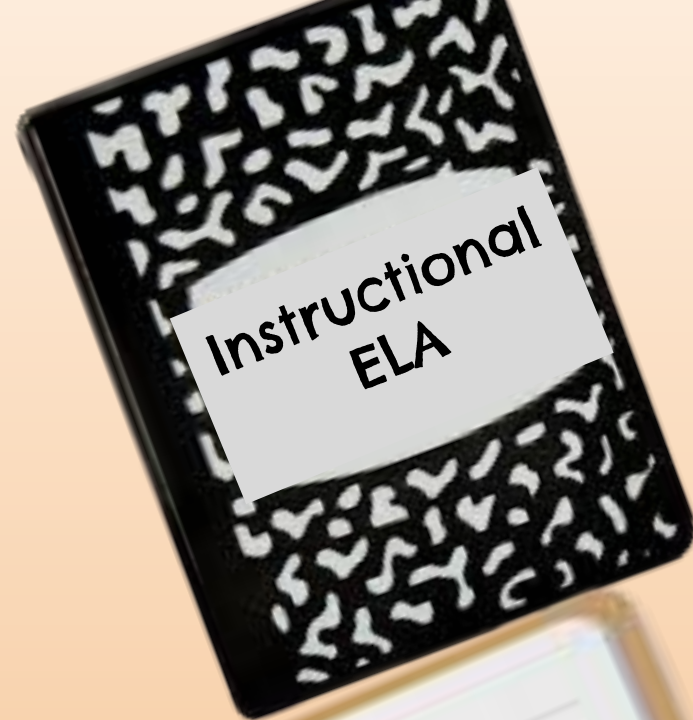
We will be returning
