Mrs. Berwanger's Science/Social Studies Class

We are continuing to work in our Science books-Unit 3 "Changes in Matter."

We spent this past week having a solid understanding of the three states of matter. We will continue to work on Lesson 2-Why are materials different? And hopefully start lesson 3 by the end of the week. Because students are allowed to highlight and annotate in the workbook, the best way to review for lesson tests is by using the book to review.



Mrs. Berwanger's Math Class

We will continue to work in our Everyday math book. We will continue to work towards our goals. Students are also practicing multiplication or Division using Rocket Math. Students are continuing to work hard as a group with fractions. Additional practice at home is very helpful. They spent all last week focusing what it looks like when finding a fraction of a fraction. They were extremely surprised and excited to see how it led in to multiplying fractions.



Instructional ELA

Students have access to leveled stories through the Learning A-Z app. They can choose a short story to read for homework every night.



Mrs. Deckinga's Instructional ELA Class

In class students have worked on citing evidence in text to support a prediction, identify main idea and supporting details in a paragraph, and organize events from a story into sequential order. Students worked on grammar lessons with adding commas into a sequence and continued editing for correct capitalization and punctuation.
