<p><b>Mr. Balderman: Science/SS</b>  <b>Social Studies:</b> We just finished our last science unit on space. Please check powerschool to make sure all assignments are turned in. The last two weeks we will be finishing with social studies. We will look at the creation of the constitution, our role in government, and westward expansion.</p> <p>Please check powerschool for missing work and grades.</p>	<p><b>Mrs. Brost: ELA</b>  <u>Reading:</u> Unit 2B 'The Great Migration' Novel found in Pearson Realize. <b>Aims Benchmark assessment this week</b>  Novel: 'War with Grandpa'- in class.  <u>Skill:</u> Main Idea and supporting details  <u>Foundational Skill:</u> Suffixes -ous  <u>Grammar:</u> Commas, Semi Colons  Grammar notes are in the virtual binder in Google Classroom.  <u>Spelling:</u> List 30 Easily confused words. Test Friday.  <b>Last test for spelling this year!</b>  Assignments are posted daily in the ELA google classroom under "Assignment Book."</p>
<p><b>Ms. Goad: Math</b>  We will be Classifying 2-D figures, Using Unit Conversions to Solve Problems, Studying Geometric Figures, Dividing Fractions, Create Graphs and Tables.</p> <p>Students should be reviewing graded assessments, notes and using IXL to practice for the <b>upcoming assessment on Friday May 13.</b></p> <p>All students have the opportunity to come and see me during WIN time every day to get extra help.</p>	<p><b>Ms. Midlock: Science/SS/Math</b>  <b>SCIENCE:</b> We finished up our Space unit in science this week. Next week, we will look at the last lessons of Social Studies on the US constitution. Please check PowerSchool for missing work and current grades as we are wrapping up the school year.</p> <p><b>MATH:</b> This week, we focused on classifying 2-D shapes into hierarchies. We classified triangles by their sides, and quadrilaterals by their attributes. Next week, we will continue analyzing quadrilaterals, and we will also look at creating tables and graphs based on patterns. Please review these skills on iXL!</p>
<p><b>Mrs. Sieger: ELA</b>  Next week, we will begin a new novel called A Dog's Life. We will read it as a class and have quizzes on it. We will have our LAST spelling list #30 Easily Confused Words. That test will be on Friday, May 13th. We are doing our last Aims Benchmark assessment also.</p> <p><b>**Please check that your child has working headphones. We use them almost every day.  Thank you!</b></p>	<p><b>Mrs. Worden: ELA</b>  In Spelling, we will be on List 30. Test on 5/13. We continue to study and discuss The Great Migration. My hope for next week is to complete an art project based on a story that can be told (either real life or fiction). We will test on The Great Migration on Tuesday, May 17. We will have our final AIMS testing next week. Students can read, work on logic puzzles, or do IXL when I am reading with students one on one. I am continuing to conference with students on their three writing projects from this trimester. We will also continue to read our small group novels.</p>
<p><b>Mrs. Berwanger</b>  Students will be working on Lesson 3 in Science. We will be able to answer the question, How can substances be identified? We will test on this lesson Friday. Please review things highlighted in this lesson to prepare for it.</p>	<p><b>Mr. Mitrovic</b>  <b>ELA</b> - Students are making great gains through Read Live as they develop their phonics and fluency skills. We will be concluding the year by finishing our book Frindle, and explanatory writing. We will also be completing our final Aims Benchmark testing next week.  <b>MATH</b> - Before our final assessment, we are studying coordinate grids, how to plot points, understanding x,y values and how following rules can change our data set.</p>
