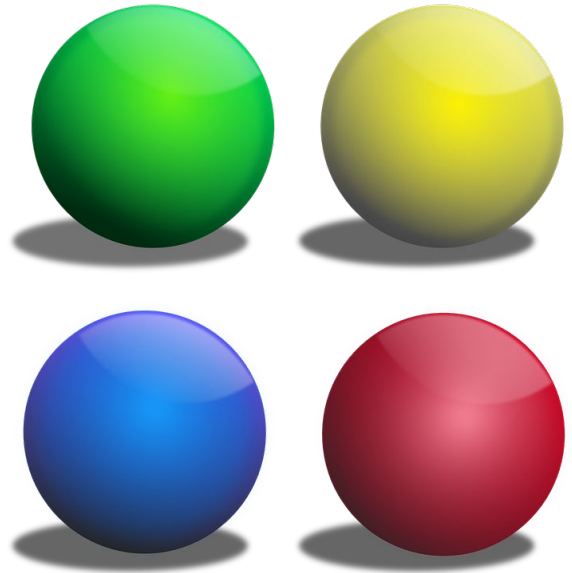
Hello Oster-Oakview Family and Friends,

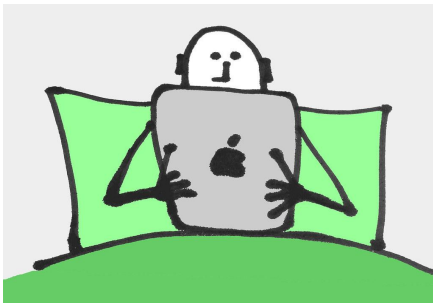
Dropping off Items

TOO SICK for SCHOOL??

Welcome again Oakview families,

Art is back at Oakview for the first six weeks, and we have been busy working on lots of different projects.



4th grade is finishing up with their Name Monsters. They created these by writing their names facing together in a mirror image form. Then they had to use those lines to create a unique monster, Alien, or creature design. This project usually brings out the most creative designs.

5th grade is continuing to work on their monochromatic moonscapes.

Monochromatic means one color, so for this painting they are only using one color with black and white. They use white to tint that color so it looks like the moon is shining light through the sky, and black to do the tree branches as a silhouette.



6th grade are creating a graphic name design. For this project they were assigned to use their name, and turn the letters into hobbies and interests of theirs kind of like the google logo.

Remember to ask your child what they are doing in art class. Projects usually come back


Parent/Teacher Conferences

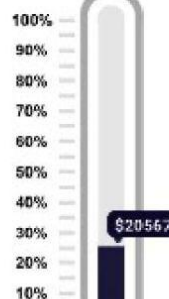
