Reading Seminar- Reading seminar is a class that focuses on reading fluency and comprehension. Students will utilize a program called Read Live several times a week. Students will be required to read passages out loud to a teacher as well as answer comprehension questions (vocabulary, main idea, inferencing, cause and effect, compare and contrast, drawing conclusions, etc.). Students are required to earn an average of 70% accuracy with answering questions each week. If a 70% is not achieved for the given week, the student will come in during advisory to practice individual reading skills. A Read Live grade will be entered into PowerSchool every other week. A progress monitor graph will also be sent home every other week so students and parents can keep track of reading comprehension progress.

- Grading Policy- Reading Seminar
 - Read Live-65%
 - Reading Skill Packet- 35%

Study Skills Study Skills is a class in which students will complete any homework that they may have. This time will allow students to catch up on assignments that they may have missed and study for upcoming tests or quizzes. Students will also receive additional help with reading fluency and reading comprehension. Students will earn a grade for this class based on reading skill practice, preparedness, and working efficiently.

- Grading Policy- Study Skills
 - o Reading Skill Packet- 80%
 - Bell Ringer- 20%

Science- Science will include a variety of topics. These topics will include: scientific method, graphing, metric system, properties of matter, energy and matter, force and motion, machines, Earth's history, and space. Students will be engaged in curriculum material through guided notes, worksheet assignments, and experiments.

- Grading Policy- Science
 - Assignments (in class assignments)- 35%
 - o Bell Ringer- 15%
 - Assessments/Projects- 50%

PowerSchool- Students will be required to login to PowerSchool weekly to check grades and to determine if they have any missing assignments. Grades will be updated for language arts, science, reading, study skills every week. I also encourage students to go over their grades with parents/guardians weekly.

Homework Policy- Homework is always due the next class day unless another due date has been specified. Please see the grading criteria below:

Full Credit - Turned in the within 2 calendar days 20% deduction - If turned in after 3 days or 3rd late assignment 50% -Never turned in or submitted after the Unit End or Unit Assessment

Retake Policy- Only tests may be retaken. Students have one week to retake the test from the day they receive the test back graded. Students are required to complete a retake form and have it signed by a parent/guardian prior to retaking the test. In any instance, students will receive the higher grade on all retakes. No extra credit will be given.

Absent Policy- If students are absent, they must check the absent bin to receive missed notes, assignments, and information. Please see me if there are any questions.

Assistance- I am available to assist students every day during advisory/lunch. I am also available in the mornings beginning at 7:45. If a student wishes to see me in the morning, please send me a brief email the night prior to let me know so that I can ensure I am available.
