Directions for Writing a Constructed Response in Reading Seminar

Remember to always write in paragraph form and color-code

Claim (Red):

This sentence must name the author and title of the article in addition to stating your opinion/what you want to prove/your answer to the question.

Reason 1 (orange):

Give a reason to support your claim/your answer.

Evidence (yellow):

Provide evidence (a quote) to support your reason.

Elaboration (green):

A: Explain the quote in your own words.

B: Explain how the quote supports your reason

Analysis (blue):

Explain how your reason supports your claim.

This statement should be analytical- involve some deeper thinking (maybe an inference). Some students may need two or more sentences to do this.

Now move on to your second reason and go through the steps again.

After you complete the steps for reason #2

Concluding Sentences (purple):

Reinforce your claim/your answer, but DO NOT repeat what you've already said. You are basically writing a mini-conclusion. This should not be less than two sentences.
