

Class Description

With Lincoln-Way curriculum semester I as a guide, students will begin to explore the culture and language of the Spanish-speaking world. Students will learn basic vocabulary, and how to begin to use this vocabulary to listen, speak, read, and write in Spanish. There will be an emphasis on the pronunciation of the language. Students will see how the knowledge they have gained in the classroom can be applied to everyday life. The goal by the end of the year is that these novice students will begin to understand and pronounce the language. Students should aim for the goal of becoming a "novice-mid" by the end of Spanish 1.
