Japanese Government and Economic System

American Occupation of Japan

- ♦ After WWII U.S. occupies Japan until 1952.
- → Main goal was to destroy Militarism (policy of strengthening of armed forces) in Japan.
- ♣ Also helped Japan rebuild into a world industrial power.
- ✦ Helped set up a democratic government.

Japan's New Government

- → Japan set up a constitutional monarchy with several political parties.
- ♦ The emperor remains as a symbol but has no real political power.
- ♦ The real power is in the hands of the Diet, an elected legislature.

Japanese Constitution (1947)

- ♦ New Rights:
 - 1) Freedom of Speech, Religion, & press.
 - 2) Women received equality & right to vote.
 - 3) Equal Education
- **♦** Forbidden:
 - 1) To wage War
 - 2) Maintain Military Forces

Japanese Economy

- ♦ Used to be based solely on fishing & agriculture.
- → Today less than 10% comes from agriculture.
- ♦ Industries have taken over.
- → Japan still has the worlds' largest fishing industry.

<u>Japanese Industries</u>

- **♦** Automobiles

- ♦ Rely on imports for resources needed such as oil.

- ♦ Hardworking and respect employers.
