City Life

- Most Chinese live in cities on the east coast.
- There are more job opportunities.
- Many cities are overcrowded.
- Most live in high-rise apartments.
- Encouraged to have one child per family.
- Often both parents work (children in child care)

Country Life

- Most Chinese in rural areas now own their own farms (once owned by the government).
- Whole family works together.
- Some have more than one child if they can afford it.

Education

- Important to have a good job (very competitive because of high population).
- Must pass difficult exams to attend universities.
- Schools are better in cities.
- Communist government has also used schools to mold people's beliefs in the government ideals.

Entertainment

- Huge holiday celebrations.
- Sports- table tennis (national sport), badminton, basketball.
- Cities have movie theaters, zoos, and restaurants.

Food

- Use Chopsticks.
- North- main staples are noodles and steamed bread/dumplings.
- South- main staple is rice.
- Both eat lots of fresh or pickled vegetables.
- Small amounts of meat accompany most dishes.
