Daily Life in India

Village Life

- The majority of people live in rural villages.
- They produce most of what they need to survive.
- Families work together.
- Many villages still don't have electricity or running water.

- 2. How do people make a living from the land? Farm, herd, fish

City Life

- 25% of the population lives in urban cities.
- Cities have modern factories, buildings, & highways.
- Major problems in cities today include:
 - -Inadequate sewage
 - -Contaminated water
 - -High percentage of people living in poverty

Families

- Live with extended families-parents, children, & spouses of children.
- Most are Patriarchal- The father is the head of the family.
- Father makes important decisions and rules.

Marriages

- Most are still arranged (around 90%).
- Families chose someone within the same caste and religion.
- Some girls in Indian marry very young usually to an older man.
- Once married brides leave their family and move in with husband's family.

Weddings

- Huge village celebrations.
- Paid for by the bride's family. Sometimes lead to family debts.
- Bride's family must also give a dowry (gift of property or possessions) to the groom.

Women in India

- Historically, women in India had very few rights.
- It was considered the duty of women to marry, obey their husbands, and have sons.
- Men must also marry because women have a creative energy called Shakti.
- Hindu widows where often forbidden to remarry and expected to spend their life in prayer.
- In Muslim (Islamic) areas of India, women are required to be subordinate to men and wear veils (Hijabs) in public places.
- Women in India have new rights in India today such as the right to vote & own property.
