Crossroads of the World

- ★ Between 3 Continents
- ★ Connected by trade routes both land and sea
- ★ Important region for military reasons because of the vital sea routes.

Major Landforms

- ★ Plateaus- Anatolian & Iranian
- ★ Mountain Ranges- Zagros & Elbruz
- ★ Much of the region is desert- Rub' Al-Khali

Water Sources

- ★ Rivers- Tigris & Euphrates, Nile in Africa
- ★ Seas- Mediterranean, Red, Arabian, Black
- ★ Gulfs- Persian

- ★ Mesopotamia
- ★ Fertile Crescent
- \star Cradle of Civilization

Resources

- ★ Water is vital, but scarce. Civilizations develop near water.
- ★ Oil- unevenly distributed; some countries wealthy & others poor.
- ★ Because of oil this region is vital economically
- ★ Other resources- salt, phosphate, copper
