Happy February! We're off to a wonderful start in the new year, and it's a joy to see our kindergarten students learning, growing, and smiling each day.

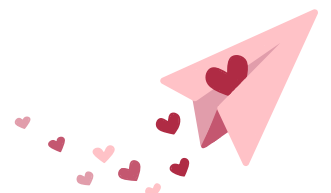

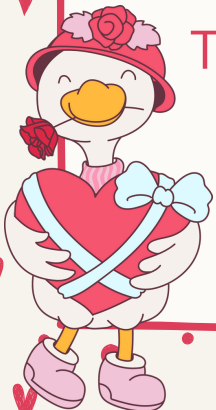
Nurse's Corner

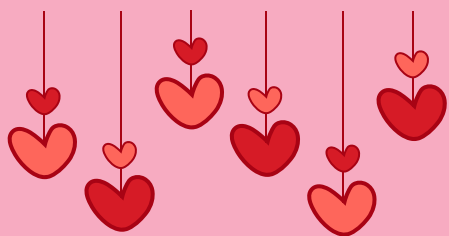
Cold, and flu season is officially upon us!

Just a few quick reminders.

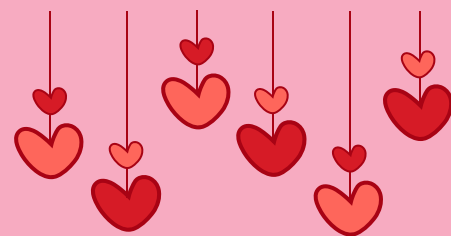
- Please keep your child home when they are sick or show any signs of sickness. This really helps to decrease the spread of illness to others.
- Keep your child home if he/she has a fever of 100.0 F or higher. Do not send them back to school until they are fever-free for 24 hours without Ibuprofen or Acetaminophen.
- Please make sure your child is vomit and diarrhea free for 24 hours before sending them to school.
- In the event your child becomes ill at school, please make sure you or your emergency contact is available to pick up your child within 30 minutes.

Also, don't forget our Family Night at Spencer Trail. It will be held Thursday, February 5th : AM families - 5:00-5:30 pm; PM families, 6:00-6:30 pm. Mrs. Tinny will have artwork displayed in the gym, and the book fair will be open in the library. We look forward to seeing you!

During January, we focused on a lot of winter stories. We talked a lot about characters, setting, and the problems and solutions of all of our stories. In February, every year, the State of Illinois Library Association sponsors a contest to let students choose the best book for the year. Kindergarten-Third grade students vote for the Monarch Award, named for our state insect. We will listen to six to eight of the Monarch Award Nominees and the children will vote for their favorite book. I will announce the winner next month. The State of Illinois winner is announced in the middle of March.


Another exciting event is starting in February: all students will now get to check out two books, if they so choose! Although with that, taking care of two books and remembering to return both books on time is a great learning experience for our kindergartners. I know they can do it! 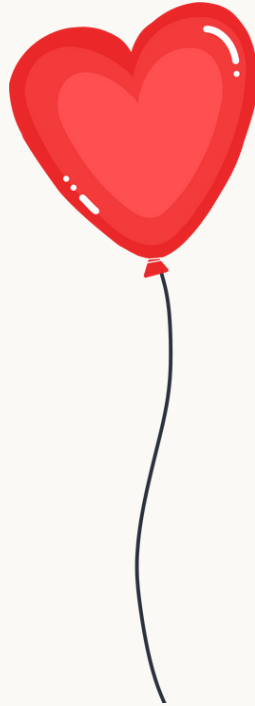

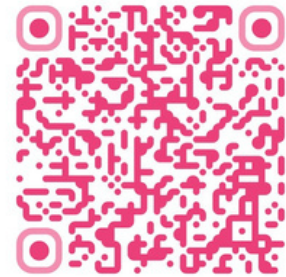
