TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS

TRANSPORTATION

Official transportation information will be available in PowerSchool on Wednesday, August 13. As new students register, transportation times are subject to change. Parents will be encouraged to check transportation again on August 19, prior to the first day of school in the event of time adjustments. The Lincoln-Way 210 Transportation Department is in the process of creating more efficient bus routes. For the upcoming school year, most bus stop locations will be located on corners. Students who use 843 Transportation will receive information regarding pick up/drop off details the week of August 11.

SCHOOL LUNCH ORDERS

The first lunch order form for the 25-26 school year will be sent to all parents on Friday, August 8. School lunch will be \$4.00 per lunch (milk included).
