Autobiography: A story written about one's own life where the writer is the main characters

Contemporary Realistic Fiction: Characters behave in realistic ways, contains a plot that makes sense, modern day setting is recognizable, and ends with a solution. Diary of a Wimpy kind

Historical Fiction: Characters may be real OR fictional, conflict is evident, and it takes place in a real and definite period in history.

Science Fiction: A story that takes place in the future, may or may not be on Earth, and the problem is solved using scientific data.

Mystery: Characters are involved in a basic problem or puzzle containing a realistic setting, clues, and distractions. The story ends with a realistic solution.

Folk Literature: There is no single author, contains "all good" or "all bad" characters, and is intended to teach a simple lesson.

Modern Fantasy: Major events could not actually happen, but the setting is usually realistic. Characters solve the problems by magical strategies, but act in realistic ways.

Informational Report: Focus and support on specific subject, organizes facts, uses examples, explanations, and descriptions.
