Adjective Notes

- -An adjective is a word that describes a noun.
- -They are often called *modifiers*, because they modify, or change, the meaning of a noun or pronoun.

Questions Answered By Adjectives		
What Kind?	expensive toys	colorful caps
Which One?	this man	these paddles
How Many How Much?	few cars	many people

Articles

- -The articles *a*, *an*, and *the* are frequently used adjectives.
 - -*The* is the **definite** article. It is pointed to a specific person, place, or thing.
 - -A and an are **indefinite** articles. They point to a member of a group of similar people.
 - -A is used before consonant sounds.
 - -*An* is used before vowel sounds.

Proper Adjectives

- -A proper adjective is:
 - -a proper noun used as an adjective
 - -an adjective formed from a proper noun
- -When a proper noun is used as an adjective and answers *What Kind?* or *Which One?*

Proper Nouns	Proper Nouns Used as Adjectives
Baltimore	<u>Baltimore</u> newspaper
April	<u>April</u> showers
Kennedy	Kennedy family

-Suffixes are added to many proper nouns to make them into proper adjectives.

Proper Nouns	Proper Adjective Forms
America	American jazz
Egypt	Egyptian empire
Florida	Floridian sunsut

Pronouns as Adjectives

-A personal pronoun can be used as an adjective IF it modifies a noun.

Personal Pronouns Used As Possessive	Adjectives
Singular	<u>Plural</u>
my	our
your	your
his, her, its	their

Demonstrative Adjectives

- -The four demonstrative pronouns *this, that, these,* and *those* are often used as adjectives.
- -When they appear immediately before a noun, it is functioning as a demonstrative adjective.
