<u>confirmed</u> - made certain that something is true (variation - confirmation) <u>naturalist</u> - a person studies or is an expert in natural history (variation - biologist)

pollution - waste or smog (variation - pollute)

<u>habitat</u> a natural environment of an animal, plant, or other organism (variation habitation)

<u>desperate</u>- feeling hopeless (variation - despair)

<u>situation</u>- a complicated condition (variation - situated)

archrival- a nemesis or enemy (variation - archrivalry)

analysis - an investigation (variation-analyze)

surveyed- to have inspected or examined carefully (variation - surveillance)

deflate - to flatten (variation - deflation)

anonymous - an unknown person (variation - anonymity)

suspended- to hang from somewhere (variation - suspension)
