hardy	-able to survive under bad conditions; tough
mediocre	-of low to medium quality; barely passable
monotonous	-always the same; not varying; boring

monotony	-lack of variety resulting in boredom
originate	-to bring or come into being
origin	-a beginning or coming into being
punctuate	-to add marks such as commas and periods to writing to make the meaning clear -to interrupt from time to time
punctuation	-the use of marks such as commas and periods in writing
ravenous	-very hungry -eager for whatever satisfies one's needs or wants
realistic	-closely resembling real life -aware of things as they are; practical
soothe	-to make calm and relaxed -to relieve soreness; to make less painful
stampede	-a sudden rush of animals or people, usually caused by fear -to take part in a stampede
