For the Week of August 23rd to August 27th, 2021

Reading - We will review the following reading skills: main idea/details, compare/contrast, author's point of view, and central message this week.

Phonics - We will practice with comparatives and superlatives, the long i sound and patterns, and the /oo/ sound and patterns.

Grammar - This week, the students will work with types of sentences: statements, commands, exclamations, and questions.

Writing - We will review paragraph writing (topic sentence, detail sentences, and closing sentence) as well as letter writing.

Math - Our math skills this week include finding differences between two numbers on a number grid, how to use the Student Reference book, a review of telling time and measuring lengths, and rounding to the nearest 10 and 100. Math homework begins this week (Monday–Thursday). *Please check your child's folder for the Unit 1 Family Letter on Monday.*

Social Studies - We will start discussing the geography of the world, where our community is in the world, how geography affects where we live, and how people become part of our country.
