Calling Your Student Off of School

If your child will be absent, please **call 815-485-2398** before 9:00 a.m. This is a 24 hour line, please leave a message if after hours. Leave your child's name, homeroom teacher, and the reason for the absence. If your child is in session and we have not received a call, one of our secretaries will need to call you to verify his/her absence. If we cannot make contact with the parent/guardian, we will call the New Lenox Police Department, and they will make a well-being check to your home. Please do not communicate absentees on Dojo, Remind 101, Seasaw, etc., the secretaries do not have access to that information.





Covid 19 Screener

Parents received an agreement to sign signifying that a COVID-19 symptom screener will be conducted daily for each child prior to arriving at the bus stop or school. We ask that you continue to do a daily self screener at home. This will not be collected.

WATER BOTTLES

Please send a water bottle in for your child. Water fountains can be used only to refill water bottles. Students cannot drink directly from the water fountains.



<u>Dismissal</u>

Please remember that if your child will be varying from their regular daily transportation, it is necessary to send a note to your child's teacher. If you need to make a change after your child has left for school, you may contact the Tyler Office, by 10:30 a.m. and we will notify the teacher of this change. Please be aware that children need consistency and changes at the end of the day can be confusing to your child and very disruptive to the class.

Half Day Dismissal is 12:15 p.m (no lunches served on half days)

Regular Dismissal is 3:40 p.m.

We usually attempt to deliver these messages in our own voices, however there are times when we are not in a location to allow us to tape and as the message is time sensitive, we use an automated voice. Snow days will be delivered through a Connect Ed.




LUNCH

Unfortunately, we must start out this school year talking about our parameters for dealing with Covid. Mask, mask mask is the way to go.
