radio



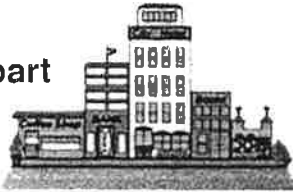
stoop

pay money for breaking a rule

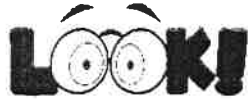
accident

cannot be returned



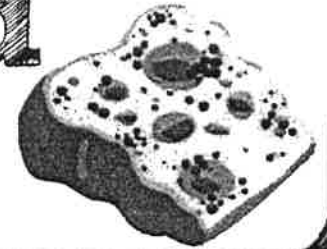

wasted



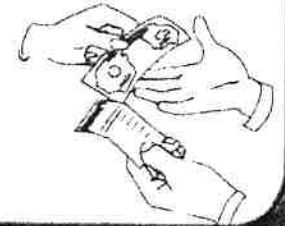
