Reading - This week, our trade book remains *The Case of the Gasping Garbage*. We will also focus on literal/nonliteral meanings, point of view, and compare/contrast.

Phonics - We will complete our work with plural nouns and will begin learning about base words and suffixes.

Grammar - Our grammar skills are using quotation marks and commas in dialogue and identifying nouns as subjects and objects.

Writing - The students will continue working on narrative writing; they will practice using dialogue and description to develop events and will also use dialogue to show character responses.

Math - We will begin Unit 2 this week. We will work with extended facts and number stories, including multi-step stories. Please look for the Unit 2 Family Letter in your child's folder on Monday.

Science - This week, we will continue learning about living things. The students will understand the importance of animals living in groups to aid in their survival.
