## Phonics and Spelling (Unit One-Module B)

This module focuses on main topics and key details in informational texts. By the end of the module your child should understand that informational texts have main topics that are supported by key details.

Our next story is titled, *The House on Maple Street*. Don't forget to practice your vocabulary words (pgs. labeled 'Supporting Text') at home!

'Focus' words for Unit One-Module B include... traditional, common, activities, mighty, fierce, snug.

We will be learning about adverbs.

## Writing (Unit One-Module B)

This module focuses on informative/explanatory writing as well as comparing and contrasting. By the end of the module your child should understand the importance of clearly introducing a topic and developing it with facts.
