Reading - This week, we will begin a new trade book, <u>Treasure in the</u> <u>Trees</u>. We will also focus on point of view, analyzing characters, and using details.

Phonics - We will continue our review of long vowel digraphs, plurals, VCCV patterns, and base words/suffix endings and will then begin studying vowel diphthongs (ou, ow, oi, oy).

Grammar - Our grammar skills are subject-verb agreement and simple sentences.

Writing - We will continue informational/explanatory writing including introducing a topic, grouping related information, and connecting ideas.

Math - The students will review counting up addition and subtraction strategies. Additionally, we will be practicing math skills using a pumpkin this week!

Science - We will begin Lesson 4 as we study what happens to organisms in changing environments.
