If your child received their physical before their 11th birthday, another appointment will need to be made to obtain the vaccine.

Welcome back to a new school year! For those of you who are new, I'm Mrs. Drews. I rotate my weeks between Bentley and Nelson Ridge, and I also supervise the Liberty and Martino Junior High libraries. I'm looking forward to sharing great books with your children! Students will go to the library once a week-

- 4th grade on Tuesdays
- 6th grade on Wednesdays
- 5th grade on Thursdays

I will be with the classes every other week and their ELA teachers will help check out books and do activities on the alternate weeks.

Library books will be checked out for two weeks, but students can return them any time before the due date. We do not charge fines for overdue books, but we do charge for lost and damaged books. Students will bring information home about library policies after their orientation sessions.

I will be teaching important life skills to Bentley students, including finding our way around a library, picking out the perfect fiction book, using books and the internet for research, and creating good research projects. But my favorite part of my job is to promote a love of reading to students! I do this through book displays, reading programs, and class activities. I have a reading program for every student and hope they all participate in at least one of them.

- **Star Reader** - Read 5 hours per month and receive a chance to win a free book or other prize.
- **Illinois Children's Choice** - Includes two programs: The Illinois Bluestem Award (grades 3-5), and The Rebecca Caudill Young Readers' Book Award (Grades 4-8). Students read books from specific lists for the chance to vote on their favorites.
- **Newbery at 100** - Special activities in celebration of the 100th anniversary of the John Newbery Award, the highest honor to a childrens' book.
- **Battle of the Books** - Team reading competition that takes place from February through May.
- **Scholastic Book Fair** - Not just a book fair, but lots of activities as well! The book fair will take place in February.

PHOTO ID FOR VISITORS

CLUBS: Students will not be allowed to sign up for more than one club each day. **If your child will not be able to attend please contact our office or send a note with your child.** Attendance is taken in all of our clubs and our office staff will call a parent if a student does not attend.

CHANGES IN ADDRESS/PHONE NUMBERS: Please notify the Office as soon as possible of any changes of address, phone numbers, employment or emergency contacts so our records can be kept current. You can also log on to PowerSchool and make changes to your information.

BUS STOP ARM ALERT: Parents, please be aware that buses on the Bentley Campus do use stop arms when loading or unloading students. It is illegal to pass a bus when the stop arm is extended even on our access roads.

BIKE RIDING: Please be advised that students should arrive at school no more than 5 minutes before the entry bell. Please make sure your student locks their bike. **SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLER SKATES/BLADES ARE NOT TO BE USED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. PLEASE CARRY.**

ATTENDANCE: Please remember to call our office at (815-485-4451) if your child is absent. Calls should be made by 7:45 AM each day. Be prepared to give your child's name, grade and reason for absence. (Note: Students may not call themselves in as absent.) If we do not receive a call we will contact the New Lenox Police Department to make a wellness check at your residence.

MEDICATION: A reminder from our School Nurse-If your child has to take medication, prescribed or over-the counter, a Medication Authorization form must be submitted. This form must be signed by the doctor and the parent. Students are not to bring medication to school themselves. It is to be brought into the Office by the parent. The medication form can be faxed to the school at 815-485-7599 by your doctor. Thanks!

DROPPING OFF ITEMS: When dropping off items during school hours (lunches, backpacks, homework, library books, glasses, tennis shoes, etc.), please leave them on the table in the building vestibule. There is a slip of paper to fill out and attach to the item. We check the table continually throughout the day.

Bentley will be open from 6:30am until 3:15pm. There will be **NO** option of returning at any later time to retrieve materials left behind by students. The custodial staff will **NOT** be available to allow anyone into the building beyond this time.



Dear Bentley families,

During the school year we cover specific lessons about internet safety. We go through this curriculum every year to reinforce to all our students the importance of making safe choices while online. We believe a crucial component to keeping our students safe online is parent involvement. To that end, this year our district is providing you with a video series on this important topic.

Cyberparenting-101: Keeping Our Kids Safe by Det. Richard Wistocki, is an excellent resource for parents. Here is the link to this [Ted Talk](#), Password: NLSP623!. Additionally, there will be information in our monthly newsletter which will include a link to more entries in this series.

Here are some takeaways from this series:

- 1) Do not allow your child to charge their device in their room at night.
- 2) Know all of your child's passwords and usernames.
- 3) Teach your child the P test- If you sent this meme or picture to your parent or your principal, how would they react? Would they laugh and say it is funny or would they be concerned or disappointed?
- 4) Everyone you talk to online should meet these 5 verifications. If you cannot physically verify this information you should not be talking to them online.
 - a) First Name
 - b) Last Name
 - c) Phone Number
 - d) Address
 - e) Where they go to school
- 5) Have a technology talk with your children and let them know they can always come to you if they feel anxious or concerned about an online interaction, and know you will support and help them without judgment or consequences.
- 6) Almost all social media outlets require users to be 13 years old or older. Your child is lying about their age on-line if they are on these platforms.

NLSD122 School Lunch Program – Making Payments

All families should receive an email from NLSD122 once every two weeks regarding the ordering of lunches. The most recent lunch order link is posted on the District website under the Lunch Program webpage. Please contact your school if you have questions regarding ordering lunches.

Payment for school lunches are due the week of being ordered. Please use the below instructions to submit a payment for your school lunches. The NLSD122 payment system uses a balance process similar to the Illinois I-Pass. You make a payment to create a PowerSchool Lunch balance in your account and then \$3.75 is debited from your PowerSchool Account each time your student receives a lunch.

How to make a payment for school lunches:

- 1) Log into your NLSD122 PowerSchool account <https://powerschool.nlsd122.org>
If you have trouble with your login credentials, please email us at ps_questions@nlsd122.org.
- 2) In the left margin of the PowerSchool screen, find and then click on "Balance".
- 3) Click on the "Make a Payment" button located in the upper right-hand corner of the Balance screen. This will take you to the NLSD122 Revtrak website to complete your transaction. Use your existing RevTrak username and password to login or create a new account.
- 4) Click to "Make a One-Time Payment" for your student, type in a payment amount, add the fees to your cart and complete the transaction. You will add your billing information the first time you checkout. The system will save your information for next time. We unfortunately cannot yet accept automatic payments so please be sure to check your PowerSchool balances periodically and make additional payments when needed.
- 5) You should now be able to see the funds loaded into your PowerSchool balance (log out of the Revtrak screen, go back to your PowerSchool account, refresh your browser, and then you should see the new updated balance reflecting the payment you just made).
