NOTES FROM OUR NURSE

It is important for our students to get enough sleep each night. According to The Sleep Foundation, school aged children (9-13 years old) require 9-11 hours of sleep each night. Each child is different and may require more or less sleep than others. Without enough sleep, children may feel irritable, tired, and clumsy. It can also make it hard to focus and pay attention which can affect your school performance! Lack of sleep also can lower your germ fighting immune system. Below are some tips to help you get your ZZZZs!



- Try to go to bed and wake up at the same time every day, even on weekends. This helps your body get into a routine.
- Turn off the TV, computer, and other devices, including cell phones, at least 1 hour before it's time to sleep.
- Follow a bedtime routine that is calming, such as taking a warm bath or reading.
- Don't have drinks with caffeine in them, especially in the late afternoon and evening.
- Don't watch scary TV shows or movies close to bedtime because these can sometimes make it hard to fall asleep.
- Don't exercise just before going to bed. Do exercise earlier in the day it helps a person sleep better.
- Use your bed just for sleeping not doing homework, reading, playing games, or talking on the phone. That way, you'll train your body to connect your bed with sleep.

NEWS FROM THE LRC

We have gotten to a great start in the LRC this school year! Students are reviewing how to use the Follett Destiny Discover App on their iPads. This app allows them not only to search for books in the Bentley library, but to also check to see what books they have checked out, when they are due, and if any hold books they may have are ready. It would be great for students to check the "My Stuff" tab the day before their Library day to see if they have any books due. In addition to this review:

- 4th and 5th grade students learned about Literary Genré by taking a "Genré Walk" through the LRC where they can look at books from these different styles of writing. (See photos below.)
- 6th grade students learned that they can search for reliable websites using Destiny Discover and save them in a Collection for further use in projects.

In October, classes will be reviewing Library organization and the Dewey Decimal System (yes... we still use that!!). We will also be looking at the Illinois Children's Choice nominated books. Students will be encouraged to read these books and write reviews about them.

I am also sponsoring a Creative Space Club this year. The students in the club are creating products to share and donate with mostly recycled items. In September we made bookmarks out of paper scraps and old greeting cards, and pencil cups made from paper tubes.




