## A Note from Nurse Cami

#### Block the sun, not the fun!

This month I thought I would provide a little reminder about sun safety. Everyone, especially children, love to be in the sun. Unfortunately, children rack up between 50% and 80% of their lifetime exposure before the age of 18. Because of this, it is important that they know how to enjoy the sun safely. Here are some reminders on how to protect your child from the sun:

#### Avoid the strongest rays of the day

Usually the hours between 10 am & 4 pm

#### **Cover Up**

Wear hats!

Wear loose fitting long sleeves/pants

Try a new pair of sunglasses!

### **Apply Sunscreen**

- ~ Apply sunscreen 30 minutes before going out in the sun.
- ~ Use liberal amounts of sunscreen. Don't forget the lips and scalp!
  - ~ Look for sunscreen that gives UVA & UVB protection.
  - ~ Infants under 6 months of age should not use sunscreen.

Also, if your child is on medication remember to consult your doctor or pharmacist about potential sun sensitivity with the medication.


