Come celebrate a winter wonderland on the farm. Music, Games, Hot Chocolate and more!

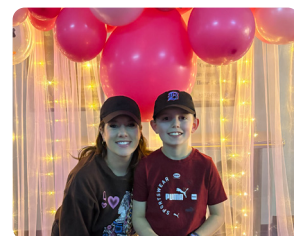


Mother & Son Valentines Bowling
