Due to the anticipated inclement weather, NLSD122 will be closed for in-person learning on Friday, January 23, 2026 and we will be implementing an E-Learning day. While making the decision to shift to E-Learning in advance is never easy, the safety of our students, staff, and families remains our highest priority.

Please take note of the following E-Learning day reminders to help ensure a smooth transition:

- **Attendance:** If your child is absent, please follow the standard procedure for notifying the school. Classroom attendance will be taken and submitted for each class period at the end of class. As a reminder, Google Meet logs each student's sign in and sign out times. We strongly encourage students to engage in online learning for a more interactive and enriching experience.

- **iPads:** If your child brings home an iPad, please ensure it is charged and returned to school with its charging cord and brick when in-person classes resume.
- **Park District ACES & Trailblazers Program:** Park District ACES & Trailblazers will provide all-day care and help support E-Learning at the Lions Community Center (1 Manor Dr., New Lenox – Entry C) from 6:30am–6:30pm. This program is only available to families currently enrolled in ACES or Trailblazers. Participants must bring all equipment needed for E-Learning, and while Park District staff will assist, students must be able to navigate their iPad independently and sit through online learning, as staff will be helping multiple children throughout the day. If the Park District cancels, updates will be posted on Facebook and the Park District website, and an email will be sent to ACES/Trailblazers families by 6:00am.
