As American Education Week concludes, it is with complete sincerity that we thank our families for sharing the commitment to education with us. The visual I imagine is your child standing arm in arm with their teacher on one side and you on the other side. There has never been a time when our partnership has been more crucial. As we head into parent/teacher conferences, our intention is to utilize the time to strengthen our partnership. The relationships built between teachers and parents, and the sharing of information back and forth, will ultimately have the greatest positive impact on children.

Please see reminders and updates below:

- Teachers will admit parents into the parent/teacher conference ZOOM as close to the scheduled time as possible. In the event that a teacher runs behind schedule, we ask parents to practice patience and remain in the waiting room until the teacher admits them.
- If able, parents should utilize the school issued iPad to ZOOM. Since the iPad has a name associated with it, this will help staff easily identify parents entering a conference. If unable to utilize the iPad, kindly identify yourself by typing your child's name as your screen name.
- The Remote Learning lunch program will resume November 30th January 18th.
- Remote Learning lunches can be picked up at Oster-Oakview and Martino Junior High.
- There is no lunch service the week of Thanksgiving or the two weeks of winter break.
- The Remote Learning lunch menu will be sent out to families the week of Nov 23rd.
- Any November or December in-person lunches already ordered will be canceled.
- Any lunch payments made to the District will remain in your account as a credit balance and can be used once schools move back to in-person learning.
- Unused snack milk will be credited back to you at the end of the school year.
- Please see the attached information regarding free meals in the community available for all children in the community. This service is separate from the NLSD122 lunch program.
- We will continue to track COVID positive cases among staff and students until January 19. If your child tests positive, please notify the school building.

With Thanksgiving upon us, we are most grateful for the gift of our students and the joy they bring us on a daily basis. Wishing our NLSD families a beautiful Thanksgiving full of love and laughter!
